TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Prices are based on 4 nights with 12hrs activities per pupil or 2 nights with 6hrs activities per pupil and include catering and hire of boots and waterproof clothing. They do not include transport to and from off-site activities. Teacher/assistant places are free.

We reserve the right to alter your programme at short notice if necessary. Programmes depend on the number of pupils and the number of staff available to assist our instructor.
